Standard Competition Terms and Conditions

These standard terms and conditions together with any specific rules set out in the Competition Notices (as defined here <u>Our Community Artwork competition | Travel Essex</u>) are the Competition Rules ("Rules") and apply to competitions ("Competition") organised by Essex County Council unless otherwise expressly stated. Qualifying entrants
